Memorial Service Information

Welcome to First Parish Dorchester. We thank you for considering our beloved church to hold a memorial service for your loved one.

Our facilities are a welcoming resource for our congregation and the Boston community at large. Having your memorial service at a Unitarian Universalist church gives you the flexibility to create a service with your own personal touches that will make your memorial service a fitting tribute.

First Parish Dorchester offers many advantages as a location for a memorial service that are difficult to find, especially in an urban area. In addition to attractive rates and amenities:

- Our church is a registered historic building in a picturesque location.
- We have a parking lot and plenty of on-street parking.
- Our first floor function spaces are fully accessible.
- The Sanctuary accessibly seats 400, plus approximately 200 more on the balcony level. It offers an antique Tracker pipe organ, a piano, and a public address system for basic amplification.
- The Parish Hall offers an 18' x 15' stage equipped with an Estonia grand piano and complimentary use of 15 tables and 85 chairs. In addition, formal tables and chairs are available to rent.
- The Allen Parlor, adjacent to the Parish Hall with sliding pocket doors, is included as a secondary space with rental of the Hall.
- A serving kitchen is available for food preparation. Dishes and a dishwasher are also available for rent.
- Second floor meeting rooms are available for family preparations.
- Our interim minister, Rev. Tricia Brennan, is available to officiate the service, though other arrangements can be made as well. Contact Rev. Brennan at minister@firstparishdorchester.org for details.
- Our church organist, Dr. Ana Sorina Popa, may be available for an additional fee. She must approve use of the organ if used by other than her.
- We would happily recommend a caterer who has provided services here at First Parish on many occasions.
- Custodial services for set up and clean up after the event may be available for an additional fee.

Some Facts about Our Building



First Parish Dorchester, Boston's oldest congregation, was founded in March, 1630. The Meetinghouse has been a landmark on Meetinghouse Hill since the 1600's. Today's Meetinghouse was built in 1896. We have recently completed the renovation and restoration of our celebrated steeple.

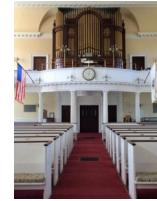

Rental Fees



A 50% down payment and separate refundable \$200 security deposit are due upon signing of the rental agreement. The balance is due two weeks before the event. In the case of cancellation more than two days before the event, the down payment is refunded. The down payment is not refunded if the event is cancelled two days or less before the event.
